

The Greeks developed the basics of their alphabet by modifying the Phoenician alphabet in the eighth century BCE. In fourth-century BCE Athens, the version of the Greek alphabet that you are reading became standard, and the cultural impact of writing was a hot topic. Plato, at the end of his dialogue called *Phaedrus*, dramatizes a conversation about writing between Socrates and Phaedrus. Socrates relates a legend from Egypt about the god Ammon wanting to bestow writing to the Egyptians because it improves memory and wisdom. Plato has Socrates critique this claim about the benefits of writing.
