To form the imperative in Greek, add the following endings to the appropriate tense stem. (For 1st Aorists, change the $-\sigma\alpha$ ending of the indicative to $-\sigma\sigma\nu$ or $-\sigma\alpha\iota$). Remember that aorist imperatives receive no augment.
