When she fainted Isidore Dockweiler, one of her lawyers, went to her assistance and she was carried from the courtroom and restored to consciousness.

Just after Mrs. Griffith fainted Judge Smith cleared the courtroom of scores of persons who had been standing, and ordered that hereafter only those persons who can secure seats will be permitted in the room.
