

Pygmalion

- Act I
 - Set up with main characters
 - Eliza, Higgins, Pickering, Mr. and Mrs. Eynsford-Hill as well as their daughter
 - Characters are introduced to each other
 - Higgins and Pickering meet, Higgins says his address and Eliza hears
 - Pickering and Higgins give pocket change to Eliza, which she later uses
- Act II
 - Begins with Higgins and Pickering together speaking about phonetics
 - Eliza shows up in a taxi
 - Eliza demands lessons and Higgins relents after Pickering bets he can't make her into a duchess
 - Lessons begin
- Act III
 - Higgins Drawing Room
 - Eynsford-Hills show up after Pickering, Eliza and Higgins
 - Eliza begins giving herself away after talking in a manner of rudeness
- Act IV
 - Higgins, Pickering celebrate victory after ambassador party
 - Eliza vents rage by screaming and running away
 - Doolittle appears, groans about the way Higgins has ruined his life by making him middle class
- Act V
 - Final scene, Eliza and Higgins part ways.
 - Narrator reveals Eliza loves Higgins
 - She wants to spend her life with him on an island, but acknowledges that her feelings are not reciprocated
 - Narrator narrates their separate lives, how Eliza has grown
