*To hold mucoperiosteal flaps, cheeks, lips, and tongue away from the surgical area.*

## Scalpel Handle and Blades

*To make incisions intraorally.*



## Periosteal

*mainly used to lift full thickness of soft tissue flaps.*



# Elevators

*To loosen and elevate the teeth in their sockets prior to extraction in order to create space and prevent trauma to adjacent teeth and tissues. The working end has thin, sharp blades that are used to cut periodontal ligaments and loosen tissue from bone.*
