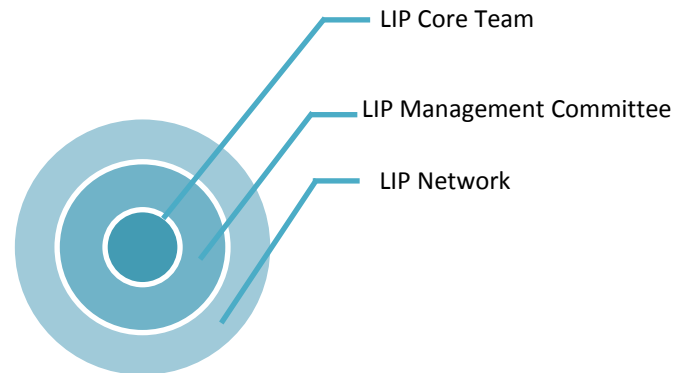
Local Innovation Partnership

Local Innovation Partnerships (LIPs) represent communities with complex challenges to the delivery of Community-Based Primary Health Care. Each partnership has arisen from existing collaborations between decision makers, local health actors responsible for coordinating and the delivery of primary health care, researchers and the vulnerable population's representative.

Governance

The LIP Network rests on the Core Team. The core team is composed of a principal investigator, a lead investigator, a local coordinator, decision makers, local health actors and representatives of vulnerable populations.

The LIP Management Committee consists of representatives of health organisations that collaborate on the project. Its mandate is to validate decisions, endorse the project's progress within the territory, anticipate developments and appoint any document deemed relevant to the Core Team.
