 comprehensible; writing is below current level; length is adequate
- Limited variety of vocabulary and sentence structures; few or inadequate use of different tenses and transitions
- Main ideas are comprehensible, some errors which interfere with comprehension (i.e. frequent word order errors
 (inversions, subordinations, basic word order); subject-verb agreement is inconsistent; noticeable spelling and
 punctuation errors); inappropriate use of English (e.g., literal translations, invented words); learner demonstrated
 limited control of the forms focused on in this assignment with quite a number of mistakes

Does Not Meet Expectations: Poor/Minimal Pass (D+, D)

- Task: did not address the topic or in insufficient manner; most required elements are missing; a number of ideas don't make sense; writing is well below current level; length is inadequate
- Little variety of vocabulary and sentence structures; no transitions
- Main ideas are difficult to understand, errors interfere strongly with comprehension (i.e. word order errors
 predominate; subject-verb agreement errors predominate; predominance of spelling and punctuation errors);
 predominant use of English; learner demonstrated no control of the forms focused on in this assignment
