Set all margins to one inch. Use an APA recommended font, such as Times New Roman 12-point font. Set line spacing to double.

The student APA title page requires only a page number in the header. Insert the page number so that it is aligned with the right margin.

The professional APA title page requires a “running head,” consisting of the title of the paper, in all capital letters, at the top of every page. If your title is longer than 50 characters, including spaces, shorten it for the running head. Type the running head in the header and align it with the left margin. Align the page number to the right margin.
